

Promotional Rules: Extra Funds Facebook Live

Promotion Type: Social Media

Promotion Detail: Participants will participate in the Closest Guess game for a chance to win.

Eligibility requirements:

All prize winners must be 18 years or older and an Oklahoma resident. All winners will be required to provide a government issued photo ID.

Entry Submission Methods

Participants can enter by submitting a comment on the Oklahoma Lottery's Facebook Live post associated with the giveaway.

Drawing Information

The Facebook Live game will have five predetermined questions that can be answered only using numbers. Players type their guess in the comment section and their information begins to display in the game. Answers are automatically calculated and results are displayed after each round. The closer to the correct answer the player is, the more points they earn. Whoever has the most points at the end, wins.

Winners will be notified via email, phone, or applicable social media platform of their winning status using the contact information provided with their entry. After initial contact, winner must complete the OLC validation process within three (3) days or winner will automatically forfeit the prize. If a winner is not able to be reached, the prize will be forfeited. Alternates will be contacted if the initial winner does not claim the prize.

The Oklahoma Lottery Commission (OLC) will take photos and/or videos of winner(s) accepting their prize. Winner(s) that claim their prize remotely or by mail will be required to submit a photo of themselves before prizes will be awarded. By accepting the prize, the winner(s) authorize the OLC to use their image/voice in recordings and photographs to be used for promotional advertising. Failure to comply will result in forfeit of prize and an alternate winner will be chosen.

Additional Scoring Information

- If the round consists of 10 answers (50 points/10 answers = 5 points) which means every next user scores 5 points less: 1st User: 50 points, 2nd User: 45 points, 3rd User: 40 points
- If the round consists of 50 answers (50 points/50 answers = 1 point) which means every next user scores 1 point less: 1st User: 50 points, 2nd User: 49 points, 3rd User: 48 points
- Additionally, the speed of providing answers is taken into consideration. The total duration of one round is split into 10 intervals.
