**BARRY FROM PRYOR CLAIMS \$1 MILLION WINNING  
MEGA MILLIONS TICKET**

**Oklahoma City (September 1, 2022)** – A Pryor resident, Barry, claimed his \$1,000,000 winning ticket today at the Oklahoma Lottery Winner Center. The Mega Millions ticket was purchased for the August 30<sup>th</sup> drawing at Prime Stop Food N Fuel located at 2986 E. Highway 20.

The next drawing for the now \$169 million jackpot will be on Friday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>.

On the July 29<sup>th</sup> Mega Millions drawing for \$1.34 billion, a \$1 million winning ticket was purchased at Chisholm Corner in Elgin. At this time, a winner has not come forward to claim their prize.
